***Recreational Outrage* Releases Debut Album to Rapturous Silence**

Melbourne-based angry bunny rock three-piece **Recreational Outrage** have released their ear-worm-infested debut album. Their raw live sound is captured in the unpretentious arrangements, single-tracked vocals and deliberate underuse of digital performance enhancing witchcraft. The album features songs from their live set, such as *Dirty Little Planet*, *Robot Girlfriend* and *F**k the Pony Club*. The CD version includes *Mystery Song*, their bizarre space/lounge cover version of a seminal track by a certain Scandinavian hair-metal band.

Basic tracks were digitally recorded in May 2011 during rehearsals in Bakehouse Studios in Richmond. Vocals and overdubs were recorded and mixed over the next year at singer/songwriter Todd Pierce's rudimentary Frog Lab studio.

Recreational Outrage formed in late 2010. Todd had written a bunch of songs that would suit an edgier sound than his usual wussy crap, so he contacted two guys he knew could play heavy: bassist/cat-wrangler Matt Howlett, and metal drummer Chris Kwan. They rehearsed a lot, they gigged a bit, then they recorded this thing.
